

- Visit admin.powerplatform.microsoft.com
- Go to "Environments."
- Select the Environment you wish to update.
- Click on "Manage."
- And then Select "Update Now."
- The process takes about an hour.
- Update is not reversible!!
- You can do this in production if you are willing to take the risk – enCloud9 has been using the update for weeks and has only seen a few issues.
